Storage Boxes vs Storage Drawers? What's right for you?

STORAGE DRAWERS

Ideal when you have a limited amount of storage space (no shelving units) and require frequent access to files.

The stronger the drawers, the higher they can be stacked and the more space you'll save:

- · Maximum strength stacks up to 10 drawers high
- · Extra strength stacks up to five drawers high
- · Basic strength stacks two drawers high

STORAGE BOXES

Here's a simple formula to help you decide:

Ideal when you have ample storage space (with or without shelving units) and require infrequent access to files. Strength determines stackability and accessibility—the stronger the box, the higher it stacks and the longer it withstands file access and handling.

FIRST— determine how often you will access the contents

SECOND - determine how much space you have for storage

Look for these banners on the following pages to quickly locate the strength you need:

MAXIMUMSTRENGTH • for frequent access

- · Best for frequent file retrieval (4x per year or more)
- · Best for heaviest use and highest stacking options

EXTRA STRENGTH • for occasional access

- Best for file retrieval of 2x per year or less (every six months)
- · Best for moderate use and medium stacking options

BASIC STRENGTH • for infrequent access

- · Best for file retrieval of once per year or less
- · Best for light-duty use and lower stacking options
